Rules For The Day

- Each team will play an equal number of games within their group;
- Each game will consist of 4 overs for each team (6 balls an over);
- For batting teams 'double runners' will apply;
- If the ball is hit over the side fences then a warning will be issued to the batsman in the 1st instant. If this occurs again then you will be GIVEN OUT!;
- If the ball is hit over or against the back fence without hitting the floor then the batting team will be awarded 6 runs;
- If the ball is hit against the back fence hitting the floor first then the batting team will be awarded 4 runs;
- If the ball is hit under the side fences then the batting team will be awarded with 1 run;
- Wide Ball's will result in 1 run awarded to the batting team and the bowler will also have to deliver the ball again;
- A NO BALL will be awarded as 1 run to the batting team and the bowler will also have to deliver the ball again;
- LBW's will apply as normal;
- The two teams scoring the most points after all games will progress through to the final.

The Umpires decision is final. Any player not complying with the rules will automatically have his team disqualified from the tournament.

The day is about having fun and though it is a competition, let's all try and remember to enjoy the day.
